April 16, Psalms 49 vs 13-20, Is death your shepherd?

Morning prayer: based on Romans 1-2 and Psalms 49:13-15

Are we trusting in false comforts that are only temporary compared to the turtle comfort that you offer us in Christ? Lord, we brought nothing into this world, and it is certain we will carry nothing out, cause us to be content with food and clothing. If we are wrapping our self in things that don't last for eternity to cover up our insecurity, then off with these garments... They are filthy. Clothe us with true garments, so the shame of our nakedness is not revealed.
