

April 30, Psalms 57, Don't look to the walls of your cave to hide you, but to His wings as your refuge

Morning prayer:

As David, his family and all the fugitives and Israel fled from Saul into the cave to hide them self... How has life and its circumstances forced you to withdraw into desolation?
