By Your Lovingkindness We Won't Be Shaken

Note: The last five minutes of the recording has an important update regarding the fellowship of the burning hearts movement.

When we refer to the movement of the fellowship of the burning hearts, we are referring to the individual work of the Holy Spirit in peoples hearts... That is joined together by corporate prayer, so that we are in one accord, and one heart.

Also, take note of the four legs of the table when it comes to the inseparable work of corporate prayer, revival, discipleship and evangelism. Corporate prayer is informed by scripture, empowered and sustained by the Holy Spirit on an individual and corporate basis - which will always be blessed with revival in the church and in the community surrounding the church. Revival provides the necessary building blocks for effective discipleship that is focused on Christ and his power, rather than our own experiences and resources. When you have mature disciples, they must follow Jesus, and "walk as he walked" ... Which will always result in the body of Christ, being accessible to the multitudes, through evangelism. The four walls of the church will come down, and God's people will be restored to a city on a hill.

Thank you for joining me and my family in praying God's heart in Psalms 21 today. Even though I don't have time to write down the scripture references this morning - It's a good idea to verify all things by the scripture and search out to see if our prayers are informed properly. Remember the Bereans - they were more noble because they searched the Scriptures to see if the things were true that Paul was saying.

"Now these were more noble-minded than those in Thessalonica, for they received the word with great eagerness, examining the Scriptures daily to see whether these things were so." - Acts 17:11
