

February 5th, Psalms 17, When I awake I'm satisfied in you

Morning and afternoon prayer prompts:

From Verses 6 - 15,

Lord, am I satisfied in this life with my children, my job and accomplishments, etc ... more than in you now and for all eternity. When I wake up, is my prayer, the same as David to behold your face. If not ... I trust you to make it so - through power of your Holy Spirit and the work of the indwelling Christ.

Save my life from those who mind earthly things, and are enemies of the cross of Christ.

"18 For many, of whom I have often told you and now tell you even with tears, walk as enemies of the cross of Christ. 19 Their end is destruction, their god is their belly, and they glory in their shame, with minds set on earthly things. 20 But our citizenship is in heaven, and from it we await a Savior, the Lord Jesus Christ, 21 who will transform our lowly body to be like his glorious body, by the power that enables him even to subject all things to himself." - Phi 3:18-21

Evening prayer prompt:

Lord do I believe that, holding back my lips from speaking, so that they can be used to speak Your words is crucial to being protected from the devices of the enemy? Lord, it's so easy to try to get vindication from the presence of others rather than yours. I often don't wait on you to speak through me... I speak words that end up in trapping my soul... When I could actually be delivered by the words of your lips. Thank you for your precious word. Jesus, thank you that you are the living Word. Holy Spirit thank you for taking up the word of God, and using it against my enemies as the supernatural sword.

"11 Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse!
