

January 29th , Psalms 11, His throne is in heaven

“In the LORD I take refuge;
how can you say to my soul,
“Flee like a bird to your mountain,
2 for behold, the wicked bend the bow;
they have fitted their arrow to the string
to shoot in the dark at the upright in heart;
3 if the foundations are destroyed,
what can the righteous do?”

Don't get this Psalm wrong... the questioning about the foundation being destroyed, is an ungodly person saying that there's no hope if the "foundation is destroyed" and that we might as well flee like a bird to your mountain because they can shoot you in darkness and you won't win. This is classic defeatism. How are we falling for this in our lives? Think about the ways you might be believing this same discouraging line of questioning. Do we think that if our political party doesn't win the race that the foundation is destroyed? Do we think if our life turned out looking completely different than what you imagined that our foundations destroyed? Do we think if her husband and wife or children don't wanna follow the Lord that our foundation is destroyed? The answer is going to come in loud and clear in the following verses. God's throne is in heaven - Therefore it cannot be destroyed. We are seated with him in heavenly places in Christ; and no one can pluck us from his hands. Have this unshakable confidence, don't let the subliminal questioning ruin your day.

4 The LORD is in his holy temple;
the LORD's throne is in heaven;
his eyes see, his eyelids test the children of man.

God's throne is in heaven, and he rules over all the affairs of men. That's amazing but even more amazing is that you belong to him and seated in heavenly places with him. And his throne is also in your heart. He's working all things together for the good of making you like Jesus. Don't buy the lie and flee for some earthly mountain. Because the wicked flee, when no man pursues them, but the righteous are bold as lion
