

March 14, Psalms 35 vs 17-28, "Your praise all day long"

Morning prayer:

Am I so desperate for to be rescued from what separate me from you today (Any, and all voices attitudes that are stronger and louder than you in my life) That I will cry out with David "how long, O Lord". Lord, do I see that what is eternally valuable hinges on you rescuing me today. My mouth must be used to praise you today! So come quickly Lord and remove the crippling work of the enemy. I know you've already won the battle and will rescue me... I will move forward, trusting that you have.

Afternoon prayer:

Lord, cause me to be confident in your righteousness that has been worked into my life, and become my own, as I have walked by faith. You judge what belongs to you - and I belong to you so don't let me be swallowed up or humiliated by false judgments, based on the works of the law, rather than righteousness by faith.

Evening prayer:

Lord, do I see other believers by who they are in their flesh, or do I see them as crucified with you and righteous by faith? I want to shout for joy over the same vindication that I have received in Jesus... For others as I do for myself. Show me those who delight in the prosperity of my faith, and separate out those who are judging me in a wrong way.

I will praise you all day long because you and your righteousness is the only thing valuable in my life!
